“Starry Night”

When and where is it?

This year's Prom will be on Saturday, April 13th from 6:30p-10:00p at the Sheraton Waikiki in the Honolulu, Kahuku and O`ahu Rooms. LJA students and guests must arrive before 7:00p and be off the premises by 10:15p. Once checked in students and guests may not leave unless they are ready to leave the Prom for the evening. Students and guests must check out with a chaperone. All bags/purses will be checked in and are subject to search.

Who can attend the prom?

All Le Jardin Academy Juniors and Seniors are invited and must complete a Prom Student Permission Form and have an approved April Progress Check on file to attend. Each LJA Junior and Senior is allowed to sponsor **one guest**. Guests must be in high school or no more than one year removed from high school (Class of 2018). The guest will need to complete a Prom Guest Form if they do not go to LJA and/or if they are an LJA HS student that is not a Junior or Senior. All guests must bring photo ID with them to be admitted. LJA students will be responsible for their guest.

How should I dress?

Proms are traditionally a formal event. Men should wear ties and a coat (this could be a tuxedo), and ladies should wear a dress/gown. Definitely no shorts, t-shirts, or slippers and remember you will be dancing!

What is the theme?

This year's theme is “Starry Night”. The theme will be reflected in the decorations.

How much is it? How do I pay? When is the money due?

The cost is **\$75 per person**. You can pay cash or check to LJA and give your payment to Mrs. Omori or Mrs. Broussard. All fees and forms (for LJA students and guests) need to be submitted no later than **Monday, April 1st**. Buffet style dinner and refreshments will be available. Dinner will be served at 7:15p. **Sorry, no refunds.**

Will there be a photographer?

Yes, Perfect Portraits Hawaii will be there to capture a formal photo. In the past package prices range from \$25 to \$60. Only cash or checks will be accepted. Package and pricing information will be sent out shortly.

What should I bring to prom?

Photo ID (guest) and camera. Again, all backpacks, bags and purses are required be checked in and are subject to search.

How do I get there?

Transportation is not provided. You may drive, be dropped off and picked up, or rent transportation like a limousine. The Sheraton Waikiki provides valet parking for \$15 (not including tip) and self-parking for \$10.
