Grades I-8 NOTES: July 22 – August 2, 2019

Location- Main Campus is on Kapaa Quarry Road. Early Care is located in the Wang Auditorium.

Every Day – Please escort your child to the Wang Auditorium and sign your child in and out daily. Pack a snack, lunch with drinks, and a reusable water bottle, unless specified on the calendar.

Pool & Beach days - Apply sunscreen! Wear swimsuit (under clothes). Bring a towel, change of clothes, and a plastic bag for wet items. Please label all items with your child's name.

All Excursions- Wear a LJA t-shirt and covered shoes. Pack personal items including lunch, snacks, a change of clothes, sunscreen, and a water bottle in a backpack. Students are responsible for carrying their belongings on excursions.

- ❖ **Computer Lab** – Students are working on enriching age-appropriate summer projects or playing educational games (on educational websites only!). Robotic coding kits, STEAM games, and activities will be available for the students to play with.
- ❖ **Pool** - Free Swim in our saltwater, heated pool. Students will be tested on their swimming ability on the first Pool Day. If they are unable to successfully complete the swim test, they will be fitted with a life jacket. Non-swimmers will have games and playing cards available at the pool area.
- ❖ **Lego Robotics** – The team at Bricks Bots & Beakers will be teaching us the 4C's (Critical Thinking, Communication, Collaboration, and Creativity & Innovation), while we build small robots with moving parts.
- ❖ **Cooking** – Students will turn into mini chefs and learn how to whip up nutritious snacks from around the world.
- ❖ **Kailua Beach** – Swimming, surfing and games on the beach. **Lunch is Provided:** pizza. Please pack drinks and snacks.
- ❖ **Chuck E. Cheese** – **Lunch is Provided:** pizza and fruit punch. Also includes 12 game tokens and a live Chuck E. Cheese show. Bring a morning snack and a reusable water bottle labeled with your child's name.
- ❖ **Summer Celebration** – Don't forget your gear! Enjoy treats and a giant inflatable water slide.
- ❖ **Secret Island** - **Waiver must be signed to attend.** Wear a bathing suit (under clothes) and apply sunscreen. Enjoy a morning of sand and water at this super secret island built by the Menehune.
- ❖ **Bingo** – Our annual Bingo-extravaganza will give our students the opportunity to practice their looking and listening abilities. We'll have awesome prizes like water bottles, journals, cookies, Lego sets, spy pens, headphones, and more.
- ❖ **Kroc Center** - **Lunch is Provided, but please provide drinks and/or water bottle:** hot dogs and fruit. Swim and slide into a day of fun at a miniature waterpark. Take a break from the heat in the Kroc Centers all-inclusive gaming room. **Swim Test is required to participate in the deep pool and high dive. Students will have to complete a 50-yard swim test with continual forward progress without stopping.** Students who do not pass will be fitted with a life jacket and allowed in the kiddie play area only.
- ❖ **Glow Putt Mini Golf** - Students will putt in an indoor 18 hole glow in dark course. Wear something white see it glow!
- ❖ **Aiea Bowl** – **Socks are required to bowl.** Students will bowl two games.
- ❖ **Manoa Honey Bee Keeper visit-** The beekeepers at Manoa will be showing us the typical life as a “bee farmer”. They will bring a small live hive observation (kept in an air-controlled, tightly sealed container) and have a honey-tasting.
- ❖ **Tiki's Koko Marina** - Unlimited video games, carnival games, sports simulator, and laser maze followed by a cool treat.
- ❖ **Bounce House** – Students will have a day of cleaning, bouncing in a large inflatable bouncer, and eating ice cream.
- ❖ **Afternoon Activities** – Extended Day Teachers will plan around the world activities after 3:00 p.m., which includes: art, gardening, cooking, games and skills, and movies!

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
