July 8-12, 2019 • 8:00am-3:30pm


This week-long summer program for students currently in grades 9-12 provides an engaging, hands-on learning opportunity for students interested in health professions.

The program will take place at the UH Mānoa John A. Burns School of Medicine in Kaka'ako.

Through gross anatomy laboratory demonstrations, clinical skills laboratories, computerized manikin simulations and standardized patient interactions, students will learn how to:

- describe the epidemiology, signs and symptoms, pathophysiology, diagnosis, and treatment of illnesses common in Hawai'i;
- perform basic clinical skills such as measuring vital signs and listening to the heart and lungs with stethoscopes; and
- interview and counsel patients.

The Medical Diagnosis and Treatment program is part of UH Mānoa Outreach College's Summer Programs. The fee is \$500. A few scholarships will be available for students attending a Title I school in Hawai'i. Please call (808) 692-0948 for more details about the scholarships.
