Le Jardin Academy uses a program called ImPACT (Immediate Post Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing) to manage concussions sustained by student athletes. This program assists our athletic health care team in evaluating and treating head injuries. ImPACT is a computerized exam utilized in many professional, collegiate and high school sports programs to successfully diagnose and manage concussions.

If an athlete is believed to have suffered a head injury during sport participation, ImPACT is used to help determine the severity of a head injury, and when the injury is fully healed. The ImPACT test establishes a baseline score prior to the beginning of a contact sport season. The baseline test may be completed via secure email link at home or in person with our athletic trainer. After a concussive injury, the injured athlete is reassessed and the scores are compared to the baseline test. Athletes will only be considered to return to their activities if the post injury scores are comparable to the baseline scores. The ImPACT test is non-invasive and poses no risk to student athletes. It is set up similar to a computer game and takes 20-30 minutes to complete. The test data enables healthcare professionals to determine when return to play is appropriate and safe. If an injury of concussive nature occurs to your child, you will be promptly contacted with all details.
