Introduction

The Primary and Secondary Programs offer additional enrichment activities that take place after school. Enrollment is offered in August and January of each year. This catalog provides a list of activities offered in Session I, which runs August through December 2022. It also includes details on registration, payment, course descriptions, and norms. Activities are listed in alphabetical order and will also appear in this order during registration in School Doc.

Le Jardin Academy adopted a [Routine Disease Control Framework](#) effective August 1, 2022. Students will be in mixed grades After School Activities.

Registration and Payment

Registration will open on August 11, 2022 at 5 p.m. and close on August 15, 2022 at 5 p.m. The registration link will be available on the LJA Website from the After-School Activities (ASA) page and will direct families to School Doc for registration. ASA does not accept any other registration form (i.e.: verbal, written, or from Vendors). Instructions are down below on what parents need to do if they missed the enrollment period.

School Doc Registration

Log into School Doc to complete the online Registration Form. Please complete one form per child. By clicking submit, you acknowledge that you have read and agree with the ASA and Vendors 2022 - 2023 policies and procedures, including rules for withdrawal, wait list, course change, and refund policies. An outline of all policies is available in this Catalog.

Course Selection

Select the desired activities for your child. There is a \$5.00 non refundable fee included for each class you select.

Submit Registration

After you submit the registration, your answers will be recorded. The ASA office will notify Vendors of their Class List (including the timestamp) on August 17, 2022. It is the responsibility of each Vendor to provide parents with important course information, including but not limited to payment instructions, wait list status, or class cancellation due to low enrollment. Any mistakes made on the form can be corrected by emailing afterschool.activities@lejardinacademy.org or requesting a correction through School Doc. All questions regarding wait list, payment, etc. will be forwarded to the Vendors for response. Parents are also welcome to contact the vendors directly.

Submit Payment

Vendors will contact parents no later than August 17, 2022 with payment instructions. Payments are made directly to vendors. Please do not send payment to LJA.

Registration Changes/Withdrawal

Any changes to the registration, including withdrawing, can be requested in school doc or emailed to afterschool.activities@lejardinacademy.org. Any changes need to be in writing.

What To Do If I Missed The Enrollment Period?

Following closure of the registration period (August 15, 2022 at 5 p.m.), Vendors will accept enrollment directly from the parents, subject to availability. If your child is accepted after the enrollment period, you are required to notify ASA @ afterschool.activities@lejardinacademy.org, so we can properly notify the student's Teacher, Head of Primary Division, Dean of Experiential Learning, Front Desk Receptionist,, and Extended Day leaders to make sure students are sent to the correct location on the day of their activity. The email must contain the following:

1. Student's name & grade level
2. After-School Activities—include the day and start time
3. Primary teacher's name
4. Whether child is in Extended Day
5. Do we need to add the Instructor or Coach's name to the "Authorized to Pick Up" list? If yes, their name and phone number? Parents can ask Instructors to email ASA; however, the above list would still need to be provided.

Registration Confirmation

After registering through School Doc, an automatic window will open, confirming that your form's answers are recorded. Parents can log in at any time and check their child's registration or waitlist status.

Registration Confirmation only guarantees your request for your child to be in a particular activity. This confirmation does not guarantee enrollment. This confirmation alerts the vendor to the student's interest in joining the class. A separate confirmation and payment instructions, sent from the Vendor, will determine whether or not your child is registered for the class.

Tuition/Payment Policy

The cost of each ASA activity varies from \$25 - \$500. Depending on the activity, additional costs, such as supplies, may apply. To know the exact amount, please see "Course Description." There is a \$5.00 non-refundable registration fee per class registered for. This fee is not part of the class tuition. Payments are sent directly to vendors following confirmation of class registration.

Parents who submit payment to the Vendor before registering their child are not guaranteed a saved spot in the class. It is strongly recommended that you confirm your child's enrollment with the Vendor prior to submitting payment. Refunds are provided only at the discretion of the Vendor.

Withdrawal/Refunds

For the Vendor's Refund Policy, please see "Course Description," or contact the Vendors directly. Should conditions necessitate a shift to Level 3 of the Routine Disease Control Framework (RDCF), Vendors will be required to provide one of the following: prorated refund, credit, or on-line class. Please see Vendors Withdrawal Policy.

For withdrawal from a class for which you have not paid, please email us for assistance at afterschool.activities@lejardinacademy.org.

For withdrawal from a class that is paid, please see the “Course Description,” for the Vendors’ withdrawal policy, or contact your Vendor directly.

School Policies

Waitlist Policy

If placed on a waitlist, you will be informed immediately in School Docs. If or when a spot becomes available, it is up to the Vendor to communicate, in writing, to the parents. Any questions from parents regarding a waitlist will be forwarded to the Vendor. ASA is responsible for notifying Vendors when their class is full. ASA is not responsible for notifying or confirming with parents when their child is promoted off the waitlist.

To find out Vendors’ Wait List Policy (i.e.: dates of notification or method of notification, if not noted in Course Description), please contact Vendors directly.

Absent, Cancellation, & Class Make Up Policies

In the event that your child will be absent, please contact the Vendor directly and cc the ASA Office.

In the event the class is canceled due to low enrollment, the Vendor will notify the parents of the cancellation and instructions on refunds (if applicable).

In the event a class is canceled due to poor weather, teacher illness, or closure, the Vendor will email parents at least two hours in advance. This email will also include instructions on the date and time of a make up class (if applicable).

ASA has reserved one week at the end of the session to offer makeup days at our Vendors’ discretion. Vendors are responsible for providing detail as appropriate.

Arrival & Extended Day Care

Le Jardin Academy, nor Extended Day, provide supervision for students during the transition time period between school dismissal and the start of their Activity. Vendors are expected to collect students in Grades K-2 from their homerooms or Extended Day classrooms. Students in Grades 3-5 are permitted to walk themselves from classrooms to the Vendor’s designated location for the activity.

Dismissal

Vendors are expected to bring students to the Loop promptly at pickup time. Likewise, parents are expected to be on-time at the pickup location. Parents should remain in their vehicles, and students will be brought to the car. Under no circumstances will students be left unattended. Please see “Course Description” for activity start and end times.

For children in Extended Day, the Vendor will return students in Grades K-2 directly to their Extended Day classroom after the activity. Students in Grades 3-5 are permitted to walk themselves from the Activity back to their Extended Day classroom in coordination with the Vendor.

Snacks & Drinks

Please provide additional snacks and a reusable water bottle. Snacks should be nutritious and not excessively sugared (i.e.: cupcake with heavy frosting or glazed donuts). If your child will be outside or involved in a physical endurance activity, you may provide a sports drink with electrolytes in addition to a reusable water bottle, Vendors will state in the “Course Description” whether a snack is provided or needs to be provided.

Non-ASA Affiliated Clubs

Non-ASA Affiliated Courses are non-profit clubs, including but not limited to CSAL, Environmental Club (E-Club), Reading Club, select sports, and others. Each club requires special enrollment requirements, such as try-outs. Enrollment instructions can be found under “Course Description”. If not, please email the vendor directly. The purpose of including such clubs in the ASA Catalog is for parents to have an all-encompassing overview of all the things students may opt to participate with.

Black Out Dates

Black Out Dates are days when there are no After-School Activities due to a special event, campus closure, or holiday. Under each activity, there will be a list of Black Out Dates.

We ask Vendors to notify parents in a timely manner when a Black Out date is approaching.

Course Descriptions

Above and Beyond! STEM Rocketry Workshop

Design, build and launch your very own rockets in this after-school workshop. This class is for creative students who like making things with their hands. Students will learn the basics of rocket design and 3D prototyping for 3D printers and Laser cutting to print their own custom rocket parts. Safety will be key as we explore what makes rockets go! 1/15 student teacher ratio.

Blackout Dates: Tuesday, October 11, 2022 (Fall Break), Tuesday, November 1, 2022 (Professional Development Day)

Terms & Agreements: Students will need to bring a laptop to create 3D files and designs for the laser cutter. Free online 3D modeling software will be used. Rocket making materials, safety equipment will be provided. Students are required to wear close-toed shoes when working in the LJA Makerspace shop. Students are allowed to bring in outside materials to use provided the teacher and parent have communicated about it.

Payment Policy: Your child's spot will be reserved when tuition is received. Price includes snacks, all safety equipment, tools, materials and rocket supplies.

Refund Policy: No refunds after the first day of school. No credit or refund given to missed classes.

Swim Lessons and Swim Club- Island Swim School, L.L.C.

Island Swim School offers caring, personal swim instruction to students in grades K-8. LJA's pool is saltwater, 25 meters long, and is generally heated to 82 degrees. Our 30 minute private/semi private (1-2 students per instructor for beginners and 1-3 for intermediates and above) lessons are scheduled at 3:00 and 3:30 on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. Our lessons are grouped for cautious beginners, confident beginners, intermediate and advanced swimmers. Our students learn water adjustment, body position and breath control. They are introduced to, and then refine, freestyle and backstroke, and progress to breaststroke and butterfly. Water safety is taught at all levels.

Students in Grades K and 1 will meet at the Garden near their classrooms after school and will be escorted to the pool. Students in Grade 2 and above may walk to the pool on their own. All swimmers will be supervised on the pool deck until their class begins. They are welcome to have a parent-provided snack and may read or talk quietly to a friend during this time. After class, children will be returned to Extended Day or brought out to the loop for pick up.

Island Swim School also offers Swim Club, an introduction to a swim team environment. Swim Club has a minimum of 4 and up to 7 students per instructor and a 55 minute class from 3:05 -4:00 on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. In Swim Club, we focus on stroke refinement and endurance. To participate in Swim Club (for grades 2-8) students must be able to swim 50 meters of freestyle continuously with good form, 25 meters of backstroke and have been introduced to breaststroke and butterfly. LJA Wild Kids After School Program

Our program is designed to offer students the freedom to make mistakes, create their own way (both literally and metaphorically), and hone their awareness of their surroundings, others and themselves. We specifically do not create structured lessons. Wild Kids is built around exploration, discovery and imagination. It is not a science class or an outdoor survival course.

After school for two hours we explore the land adjacent to Le Jardin Academy's campus and enjoy mud slides, scavenger hunts, hiking, tree climbing, making up games, building shelters, creating nature-based art, camouflage activities, scouting for trails, tracking birds, and searching for the magical forest elves known as "Little Greenies."

In Wild Kids, we encourage students to expand their comfort zones by trying new things and making mistakes. We firmly believe that the most solid self-confidence is built on the moments when we must rely on our own ingenuity and communication skills. For our program, this takes the form of teaching through questions and experience. We do not provide students with all of the answers, but guide them through their own problem-solving processes. This may include the following experiences: what to do with an invasive species, how to find the trail, how to build a shelter without man-made objects, how to identify a bird or plant, how to create a game that is safe but still fun, how to climb up a hill without creating erosion, how to keep everyone in the group safe, what to do if you get hurt, what to do about mosquitos, how to run in the forest without tripping, what to do when you make an unsafe choice, and a host of other conundrums that we may come across on our adventures. Allowing students to develop their own solutions and manage their own reactions is perhaps the most important lesson we provide.
